#### The Coming Judgment

<u>3</u>Most importantly, you must understand that in the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires. <u>4</u>"Where is the promise of His coming?" they will ask. "Ever since our fathers fell asleep, everything continues as it has from the beginning of creation." <u>9</u>The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise as some understand slowness, but is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish but everyone to come to repentance. <u>10</u>But the Day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and its works will be laid bare. <u>11</u>Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? <u>2 Peter Chapter 3:3-4,9-11 (BSB)</u>

Who will take the necessary risks to rescue them from the impending fire? Who will dare to share the Gospel with them? The Cross is the answer to that question. We cannot remain indifferent before such an amazing love. As Jesus's followers, we're all called to share the Gospel. That call can sometimes intimidate us. We may even shiver at the idea.

The Fellowship of Christian Farmers – Canada (FCFC) trains volunteers to share the message of salvation in Jesus Christ across Canada from Nova Scotia to BC. Volunteers comprised of interdenominational evangelical Christians, collaborate to present the Gospel message in 5 colors at marketplace events such as fairs, festivals, trade shows, etc. Will you volunteer? We can train you.

Let us pray that the Lord will set our hearts on fire with his love for the world. This is our mission field! Let's go!

Fewer and fewer people in Canada regularly attend church. In response, the Fellowship of Christian Farmers – Canada (FCFC) is taking the message of salvation in Jesus Christ across Canada from Nova Scotia to BC.

### The Bead Story:

This is the Good News that the Fellowship of Christian Farmers shares with everyone.

We use five colours as a reminder.

- Gold: Gold reminds us of heaven, a beautiful place with no sin, pain, or sorrow. Jesus said, "I go to prepare a place for you." God wants us to go there too: Yes, "God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him would not be lost but have eternal life" John 3:16
- Dark: But we have a problem! Sin separates us from God which separates us from heaven. The bad news is that we are all guilty. "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23
- Red: What is the solution?

  Red the blood of Christ. Two thousand years ago Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came into the world. He led a perfect life and he was crucified for us to pay the penalty for our sin. Romans 6:23: "...but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
- White: If we believe this in our hearts, admit we are sinners and sincerely ask for the forgiveness of Jesus, God has promised to forgive us. Then in His sight we are now pure as the white colour represents. This is the Good News! This is a free gift and, like any other gift, if we don't take it, we don't get it! Jesus Christ offers salvation to everyone but only those who accept Him as Saviour and Lord receive the gift of salvation.
- Green: Spiritual Growth. If we believe, we will want to grow to know God better. We can grow by praying, reading and studying the Bible, being good neighbours, worshipping with others and telling others the good news.

What about you? Have you accepted God's gift of salvation?



## Prayer Request and Financial Update Brad Wilson, Executive Director

Greetings from the Fellowship of Christian Farmers Canada! In 2023, more than 100,000 people across Canada heard the Gospel message at one of our outreach events; Thanks to the faithful volunteers from different evangelical churches! Thank you, Lord!

Our 30 chapters had a variety of outreach events. From 2-3 gathered at a park on Saturday afternoons in Kelowna to a 10-day Western

Rodeo Festival at St-Tite, Quebec, to the Canadian National Exhibition (CNE) in Toronto, where dedicated volunteers shared 12 hours a day for 18 days

In over 100 venues, people lined up to receive a free gift and patiently and intently heard the Good News. Our goal is to share the simple and concise five-colour Gospel story within 3-5 minutes. We offer a copy of God's Word (between 15,000 and 20,000 copies graciously provided by ShareWord Global). We also try to connect people with a local church for discipleship and growth. From the East to the West, we were encouraged by the English and French Chapter reports submitted. They contained stats, testimonies and amazing stories from our volunteers (see p. 6-8).

### Recognizing our Québec Field Representative Jessynia Théagène

"You are young, but don't let anyone treat you as if you are not important. Be an example to show the believers how they should live. Show them by what you say, by the way you live, by your love, by your faith, and by your pure life." 1 Timothy 4:12

As an answer to prayer, a young Montrealer, 24 years of age joined the FCFC leadership team in Québec (QC). Sylvain & Émilie Couture were the Field personnel in leadership in QC at the time. Émilie recalls the moment "Seeing that the task does not cease to grow, we asked God for help. God heard and responded in sending Jessynia Théagène." Jessynia's testimony demonstrates the astounding manner in which God called her:



"During this time I clearly felt the call of God to get involved as an evangelist. Then I asked God, 'How can I combine my passion for both agriculture and evangelism?' In response to my prayer God revealed to me that I was an 'agrochristian'. 'Agro' in Greek means 'fields'. God has called me to be a Sower of seeds in His missionary field."



From an assistant role to apprentice-coordinator, Jessynia continued to demonstrate her dedication and wiliness to serve. She shared the Gospel message at events and assisted at the booth as needed. She helped in presenting the FCFC ministry to churches and assisted with the volunteer training. She contacted the organizers of public events, prepared the volunteer schedules and ordered the required

For two years, Jessynia gained valuable experiences as an apprentice under the leadership of Sylvain Couture, the QC Fieldman. She then continued under the leadership of Robert Doran, the interim fieldman after Sylvain resigned in 2019. Using their combined talents, Robert and Jessynia did a great job of continuing the work of the ministry in Québec. They launched an Inter-chapter AFCC Quebec Newsletter, so that all chapters would know the schedule of activities and have news of what is happening in other districts. An administrative team of volunteers was also established and it included seven administrative roles. All these elements, from team building, communication and sharing the torch would prove to be beneficial for what lay around the corner.

In 2020, she stepped up to her new leadership role as Field Representative for the province of Québec. Shortly after, she faced the pandemic and its impact on events and volunteers. Surrounded by the support of a strong FCFC Québec team that was cultivated prior to this season, she was able to meet the challenge. With the use of online technological tools, they continued to evangelize. She also mobilized Chapter volunteers through prayer and team building until they were able to return in the marketplace.

For years, Carol and I have been asking for prayer to establish a new Fellowship of Christian Farmers-Canada (FCFC) chapter on the Sunshine Coast. The Sunshine Coast is one of the most beautiful parts of BC, still part of the mainland, right on the edge of the Pacific Ocean. However, it is accessible only by our BC Ferries, as if it were an island unto itself. There are no roads going to this part of the province.

After scouring the internet for years and making applications to other venues, the Wood Expo suddenly appeared on my screen from nowhere. We just knew this must be God's answer to our many prayers. After making a quick call to Pastor Ivan Fox, of the Sechelt Life Church, to confirm he and his small congregation of about a hundred were ready to join us in evangelizing the area, we received his emphatic YES! So, we booked the event with less than ten days to seek vendor approval, load up our van with 600 sticks, all the equipment, book our trip, and add some luggage.

Not so fast, because after a lot of searching, we managed to find what seamed to be the last motel room in town, and the only Ferry reservation we could get, one day earlier than we planned. God gave us a late-night passage. The problem now was, our Ferry booking was for Thursday 10:00 PM on the same day as my angiogram appointment that afternoon. Now why would God put these two bookings together on the same day?

We resolved to say it must be to stretch our faith, knowing He will work it out or He would have blocked this show as He had done so many before.

After arriving in our room on the S. Coast at midnight, we now had all day Friday to recover from a swollen and throbbing right arm. The doctor would not allow us to go without my commitment not to use it for 48 hours.

We scheduled our Training of 9 volunteers for Friday night at 7:00 PM, following our assigned setup time of 5:00 PM. When we arrived at 5:00 we discovered we had been assigned one large corner of the second floor, with no elevator access. However, lots of volunteers emerged quickly to carry our sticks and equipment upstairs, which made light work of it. And, as it turned out, we had the perfect spot with lots of room to spread out sharing the 5-colored beads with as many as 5 groups of guests at the same time, all one-to-one with as many volunteers from the church. It was awesome to see some sharing for the first time. While others had the joy of leading someone into a personal relationship with Jesus for their very first time! You could spot those folks very easily as their feet were now several inches off the floor, and their smiles went from ear-to-ear. How God blessed those volunteers, their church, and Carol & I that day! It was all "more than you can ask or imagine"!

We were blessed with nearly two dozen guests (new born/again believers) who will be joining us "when the Roll is Called up Yonder"! That made everything we had gone through to get here all completely worthwhile, with our faith having been stretched yet again. It seems our God has a way of doing that with every new event FCFC engages in.

The bonus for Carol and I was to join Pastor Ivan in a presentation on Sunday morning, and to see so many eager volunteers committed to start their own chapter, <u>right</u> <u>away</u>! We stayed another night to help organize four of them in their new chapter positions and to complete the necessary paperwork.

Carol and I finally got off the Sunshine Coast at 6:30 PM, Monday night, all tired but excited after having accepted God's very strange timing with my angiogram appointment, the ferry delays, the overbooked motels, and being unable to reserve our passage back home on Sunday afternoon as we had expected. God's perfect timing of all these events turned out right again, for reasons we had not known in advance. Praise the Lord!
